3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Department of Edu-

5 cation Protection Act".

6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

7 Congress finds the following:

1SEC. 3. PROHIBITING USE OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS TO2REORGANIZE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, none of 4 the funds made available by previous Appropriations Acts to the Department of Education for obligation or expendi-5 ture in the current fiscal year may be used for any activity 6 relating to implementing a reorganization of the Depart-7 ment that decentralizes, reduces the staffing level of, or 8 alters responsibilities, 9 the structure, authority, or functionality of the Department, relative to the organiza-10 tion and operation of the Department on January 1, 2025. 11
